I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Vice Chairperson Krysty Carr after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for October were approved as submitted.

II. NOISE REPORT

Mr. Speake stated that for the month of January there were 24 noise complaints and 47 complaints in February.

Ms. McClure stated that she lives on Heron Ridge subdivision in Heathrow. She stated that in the past few months she has noticed an increase in aircraft flying over that area and was wondering why it's happening.

Mr. Ellison presented flight data over and around the area of Heathrow for Ms. McClure. He also explained the primary purpose of Air Traffic Control and why aircraft are routed over this neighborhood. It was stated that a couple of airlines currently serving the airport plan to upgrade part of their fleet with quieter and more efficient aircraft within the next several years.
