I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for April were approved as submitted.

III. OLD BUSINESS- Mr. Speake stated that the Noise Complaint Mapping System is completed and is being tested. A few bugs were identified yesterday that are being corrected. He stated that he hopes to produce a map from it by the next SANAC meeting. Mr. Speake stated that this is the first generation of this mapping system and that he hopes in the future to have it updated with additional features.

IV. NEW BUSINESS- A discussion was held about possibly changing the SANAC meetings from a monthly meeting to a quarterly meeting.

Mr. Konstan stated that the Bylaws for SANAC state that the committee will meet monthly and at a minimum quarterly. Chairman Pennington indicated that he thought the SANAC meetings should be changed from monthly meetings to quarterly meetings beginning after the meeting on July 14, 2009. The Chairman commented that unless something was to come up or the public requested a meeting, the meeting would be held quarterly.

Mr. Jack Taylor motioned to approve the change as stated by the Chairman and Mr. George Speake seconded the motion. All SANAC Board Members unanimously approved the motion. Mr. Speake stated that he would like the minutes for the meeting to be e-mailed to each Board member within a week following each meeting. Any changes needed should be forwarded by the members following which the minutes will be then posted on the website. The minutes will then be approved at the next SANAC meeting.
