I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for June were not approved due to a lack of a quorum.

George Speake presented the noise report for June. There were a total of 59 complaints from a total of 6 different complainers.

Noise complaint equipment was put out on Mr. David Williams property from June 25th to June 29th. Mr. Speake stated that the data put him at an average of 53.5 dbL. Mr. Dale stated that Mr. Williams is in the noise contour for residential property to be bought unless the FAA rules that it is not eligible. The appraisals for Mr. Williams property have been done and are being reviewed by the appraisers and will be turned in on or before August 1st.
