Tuesday, October 13, 2009 - 9:00 a.m.

I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Sanford Airport Noise Abatement Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Wes Pennington, after which the mission statement was read. The minutes for September were approved as submitted.

Mr. Pennington stated that in the October committee meeting the Airport Authority Board notifies the committee of their appointment for the Chairman position for the subsequent year. Mr. Pennington stated that this was not presented to the Board in time for this meeting and that according to the Bylaws he would continue as Chairman until the Board took action on the matter.

II. NOISE REPORT

+Presentation and comments from Committee / Public

Mr. Speake presented the noise complaints for the month of September. He stated that there were a total of 8 complaints for the month. Mr. Speake stated that for the 3^{rd} month in a row the Airport had over 20,000 operations.

Mr. Speake stated that Mr. Dale has asked that the Part 150 Study be updated with the Master Plan update.
